First mixed by American bartender Fernand "Pete" Petiot at Harry's New York Bar in Paris during the 1920s.

## French 75

Gin, lemon juice, and sugar. Served over ice in a narrow glass topped with prosecco, brandied cherries and a lemon twist.

The name refers to an artillery piece used in World War I. Popularized at the Stork Club.

## Martini

Vodka and dry vermouth, and perhaps a dash of orange bitters. Stirred and served up, with an olive or a twist.

Differing storied accounts as to its origin.

## Bramble

Gin and lemon juice, agave syrup and a dash of creme du mure. Stirred and served up, with a blackberry and lemon zest.

Differing storied accounts as to its origin.

**Tom Collins****£7.50**

Gin and lemon juice, agave syrup topped with soda water.

The original Collins mix with gin. This late 19th Century number is exceedingly simple and exceptionally good.
